Applications are invited for the post of Consultant in Occupational Medicine based within NHS Grampian's Occupational Health Service, GO Health Services).

NHS Grampian Occupational Health Service is a modern, progressive multidisciplinary team delivering services to both NHS and external clients. The service operates in mixed urban and remote and rural environments with a number of bases including Aberdeen, Elgin in Moray and Kirkwall in Orkney.

A broad range of external work is undertaken on a commercial basis with other employers and through sub contract arrangements with other private and NHS occupational health providers.

Health Working Lives specialists provide workplace visits and advice on occupational health, safety and wellbeing and the Working Health Service team provide a free, rapid access service to Occupational Health Services for employees of businesses of less than 250 personnel. The service is always seeking to develop further business opportunities. We have a strong emphasis on quality improvement and are currently working towards SEQOHS accreditation.

This is a training department with strong links with the University of Aberdeen and Robert Gordon University and both teaching and clinical research are actively encouraged. We are an enthusiastic service keen to encourage personal and professional development.

The post is based on the Aberdeen Royal Infirmary site. This teaching hospital has around 900 beds and is a tertiary referral centre serving a population of over 600,000 across the North of Scotland.

Aberdeen is a particularly attractive area in which to live and work, with a wide range of housing, excellent state and private schooling and extensive sport and leisure facilities. There are good road and railway links and the Scottish mountains are just a short distance away.
