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1. Introduction & Overview

B. Braun Medical Ltd is a member of the B. Braun Group, one of the world's leading health-care companies. B. Braun manufactures and distributes on a global basis, employing more than 50,000 people worldwide.

1.2 B. Braun Sterilog Ltd - Company Overview

Working from world class facilities, B, Braun Sterilog both manages the safe, stringent, centralised cleansing and decontamination of medical instruments and allows for those instruments to be tracked, right to the moment of disposal, to ensure the ultimate patient protection.

The services and facilities provided by B. Braun Sterilog Ltd have been designed to specifically meet and surpass the challenges faced by today's hospitals and health-care professionals.

With the cleaning and sterilisation of surgical instruments never having been more closely scrutinised, B. Braun Sterilog Ltd, through investment and careful planning, is able to offer decontamination and sterile services to support the needs of modern health-care providers.

As well as Occupational Health services such as management referrals, B. Braun Sterilog Employees require the full course of Hepatitis B vaccinations to be able to carry out the full range of roles available. With over 185 staff covering shifts that include nights and weekends, we require onsite vaccination clinics to ensure this need is met.

1.3 B. Braun Avitum Ltd - Company Overview

B. Braun Avitum delivers high quality, cost-effective dialysis and extracorporeal blood treatment systems and solutions to a growing number or patients. Our patients can rely on a long-term approach and healthy organic growth.

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As a market leader in dialysis technology, we have new product innovations to improve dialysis efficiency and enhance patient care. The combination of our expertise delivering both products and services to the home haemodialysis (HHD) market. Our HHD programme is individualised for each patient's specific requirements for home installation, training and support.

B. Braun Avitum are a partner to the NHS and there are currently six dialysis units based in South Wales and Basingstoke. Patients must attend their local Avitum Unit three times per week for four hours at a time and units operate six days per week every week. With a team of around 125 staff across all six units, treating around 275 patients per week it is imperative that the right Occupational Health Services can be delivered. This includes Fit to Work certificates and all required vaccinations and blood tests which includes Hep B Surface Antigen, HIV and TB.

1.4 Overview & Objectives

B. Braun currently employ around 1,220 staff across our different therapy areas who have a range of roles from office and operational staff that are primarily based at our Head Office Sites in Sheffield, to field-based sales staff and nurses in renal, IV therapy and continence care. We are looking to appointment an Occupational Health provider/s who can service staff across the UK including Wales and Scotland.

The contract will involve development and the provision of services, achieving key performance indicators as an effective, efficient, and proactive Occupational Health Service to support B. Braun to on-board new starters, manage attendance, health issues, risks and to demonstrate a reduction in sickness absence levels year on year.

We are looking for a provider to work with us to guide us to the right vaccination and Occupational Health solutions with the main key objectives being as follows:

1. Assess Fitness for Work

- Using pre-employment questionnaires and assessments for employees prior to their contract start to determine their fitness to work.

- Processing Management Referrals to evaluate an employee's ability to perform their job duties safely, recommending reasonable adjustments or accommodations to support employees in their role.

- Providing guidance on rehabilitation and return-to-work plans for employees recovering from illness or injury.

2. Compliance with Vaccination Regulations and Best Practice

- Identifying and advising what vaccinations each role requires and delivering these in a timely manner to ensure employees are appropriately protected and regulations and guidelines are adhered to.

3. Maintenance and Promotion of Health

– Ensuring that employees maintain their health and working capacity through appropriate preventative measures and health promotion activities

7. Pricing Structure

All prices must be shown with a full clear breakdown for each service per visit per site using Appendix D and/or Appendix E as appropriate to record this. We will not accept the total price for all services at each site, only a full clear breakdown will be accepted.

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The prices proposed will be fixed ie not subject to rise for the contract period subject to agreed Service Level Agreements being adhered to.

For contracts of 12 months or more, B Braun Medical Limited reserve the right to review prices. Contractual Partners are expected to remain consistently competitive to benchmark prices in the marketplace.

8. Contract Management / Reporting

Please provide specific names and details of a dedicated and appropriately qualified team, including a Contract Manager, to ensure all works are carried out efficiently.

Review of the contract will take place weekly for the first month. Moving to monthly after this providing implementation is successful. Please provide specific details regarding the location of the office from where the terms of the contract will be operated from.

9. KPI / SLA's

Please review and complete Appendix F. The Nominated Contractual Partner is responsible for managing the agreed Service Level Agreements. A report will be sent monthly to B Braun's nominated Category Specialist for review.

If the Service Level Agreements detailed in Appendix F are not achieved for three consecutive months, then B. Braun reserve the right to apply appropriate penalties and / or terminate the contract with immediate effect without penalty.

B. Braun reserves the right to review the service at regular intervals and if necessary, propose changes in order to improve the level of service.

10. Health and Safety

All staff must comply with The Health & Safety At Work Act 1974 at all times as well as other Health and Safety Regulations. If staff / contractors do not comply with the requirements of the legislation they may be asked to leave the site immediately.

Site Rules must be adhered to avoid disruption at all costs.

11. Sub Contractors & Specialist Subcontractors

In every instance all contractors and subcontractors must announce their visit in advance of attending site, report to the site manager and sign in & out of the unit visitors book.

Please provide details of any complex services where subcontractors will be used.

It is preferred that all in house engineers are appointed as a first point of contact and specialist sub contractors are only to be used if absolutely essential, such as complex emergency situations.



12. Implementation

13. Tender Condition

In issuing this Invitation to Tender, there is no obligation for B Braun Medical Limited to select and procure all, or some, of the services offered.

B Braun Medical Limited shall not be liable for or required to pay any costs, expenses or losses which may be incurred by the Contractual Partner in the preparation of the Tender response.

Limitations in responsibility by the Contractual Partner shall be clearly stated in the Tender response. Undeclared limitations will not be accepted by B Braun Medical Limited.

None of the documents may be altered by the Contractual Partner.

The Contractual Partners are to submit a fully qualifying bid. Any alterations which the Contractual Partner believes to be beneficial, should be detailed in a separate letter accompanying the Tender response. B Braun Medical Limited reserves the right to change any aspect of this document.

Tender responses must be valid for minimum of 90 days.

B Braun Medical Limited is not bound to accept the lowest of or any offer of any Tender and reserves the right to accept an offer either in whole or in part of any Tender unless the Contractual Partner expressly stipulates otherwise.

All prices must be quoted on the basis indicated in the specification and should be fully inclusive of all charges relating to the provision and performance of the Service VAT should be shown separately.
