- Vaughan Parsons Project OH risks associated with Covid infection among NHS workers in England. Export occurring from ESR system – with Prof Coggan and colleagues at Imperial - that captures sickness absence in the workforce. Also processing Anybody and Antigen results. Next meeting – summary information
- Prof Martie van Tongeren looking at outbreaks and designing protocol for workplace outbreaks. Also risk perceptions on transport; and study on food industry. As part of wider projects commissioned by Dr Andrew Curran looking at transmission in the workplace.
- Dr Rob Aitken variety of IOM Health risk management projects. UK associate status in Horizon Europe -so UK researchers can still participate
- Michael Whitmore RAND Britain's healthy workplaces data continuing. Looking at NIHR opportunities. Released information on financial wellbeing with Wellcome foundation
