Some of these services you can already access through the NHS, others are new or enhanced through P4P - including an adult health check every two years, additional vaccinations and cancer screening programmes. It is a central part of how we support our employees and their families to actively manage their overall health.

The services offered have been chosen because they demonstrate high value in preventing ill health or detecting early disease. They are also aligned with WHO recommendations.

The UK P4P launch was the final country to launch over a 5-year period. We are proud to say that all 100 000 of our GSK global employees and their dependants in the 150 countries that we operate in now have full access to this trailblazing programme.
