

SOM GROUP MEMBERSHIP

SOM's group membership is designed for occupational health (OH) teams and OH organisations who employ multiple OH professionals.

The more OH professionals sign up, the more you save. Each member in the group receives full member benefits, at a reduced rate per person.

Benefits include:

- a paper copy of the *Occupational Medicine* journal nine times a year; allowing teams to access articles that help address day-to-day challenges, keeping them at the forefront of thinking and practice in OH
- monthly e news
- access to regional groups, and discounts on our annual conference and events
- competitive indemnity insurance for nurses and doctors (excluding international members)
- a free online appraisal tool for nurses and access to appraisal services for doctors
- free monthly webinars (e.g. on confidentiality, stress, MSK etc.)
- structured peer support package providing member to member advice
- special interest groups e.g. on MSK, HAVS, Mental Health, and Occupational Health Technicians and Disability Assessors

How to Join

E mail membership@som.org.uk with details of the number of members you wish to apply for, and your invoicing details.

Note:

- Each member needs to register on our website to create a login to our Members Area.
- Any members of your group who are currently already paid SOM members will be able to take part in this group offer (re-imburement will occur).
- "A group" is defined as three or more people receiving a salary from the same employer.
- Membership is paid for annually by the employer.
- At least one member of the group should not be a medical doctor.

Pricing is in the following categories, on a pro rata basis January - December:

Based in UK/EU	Based outside UK/EU
3 to 5 staff - £207 per head	3 to 5 staff - £155 per head
6 to 10 staff - £199 per head	6 to 10 staff - £149 per head
11 to 20 staff - £195 per head	11 to 20 staff - £146 per head
20 or more staff - £190 per head	20 or more staff - £142 per head

This constitutes a significant saving on our 2022 fee for individual membership, which is £237 (£177 for international members).

There is a further £20 reduction (£15 for international members) if the journal is provided online rather than by paper copy.
