OCCURRENCE-BASED MEMBERSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

In order to qualify for membership MDDUS traditionally required members to be on the relevant GMC specialist register or on the GP register. However, we recognise that occupational health physicians may come from a range of clinical backgrounds and therefore we will consider applications from doctors who are not on the GP or specialist register. As a guide, doctors would be expected to hold at least the Diploma in Occupational Health and be able to demonstrate two years' experience of working in occupational medicine.
