


Age Profile of Trust Staff


Age band v Headcount

Improving staff musculoskeletal health at SFHFT

Research shows early intervention advice/management in staff with musculoskeletal (MSK) problems is key to helping:

- reduce rate of absence & facilitate quicker return to work, with fewer days off
- reduce rate of reoccurrence, risk of condition worsening
- reduce rate of the injury leading to other health problems such as depression
- improve cost savings
- provide vital proactive early MSK intervention for an older working population








Improving staff musculoskeletal health at SFHFT Physio

Background:

- Changes required in previous OH Physio service
- November 2016 H&WB CQUIN monies available introduce a pilot physio Staff Selfreferral service
- 2/7 a week in tandem with existing service
- Followed local and national guidance
- Liaison with other physios and OH physios







Improving staff musculoskeletal health at SFHFT Physio

Pilot aims

- Initiate a fast track Staff Self referral service for new acute MSK <3/12
- Advise staff on accessing physio services at work /closer to home
- Provide information for staff on MSD self- management and prophylaxis
- Initiate MSK Health Team: scoping service for workplace ergonomics





Improving staff musculoskeletal health at SFHFT Physio

Pilot results (50)

95% service saved GP visit

service reduced time off work (if off work)

service prevented them going off sick

- Cost savings of approx. £76,000
- Business Case- established 1WTE physio OH Staff Self-Referral Service
- included previous physio staff member
- Previous service wound down
- Came into post April 2018



- Established physio advice and self –referral service
- Physio MSK drop in sessions with H&WB team
- Physio intranet MSK resources
- Links to the main physio department- classes /guidelines
 /staff awareness /professional support
- Body Mass Analyser
- Referral to community exercise programmes
- Early management of MSD sickness
- Part of Occupational Health Team
- Part of MSK Health Team

Approach to MSD since April 2018

- Established MSK Health Awareness Team
- Ergonomics intranet resources –managers and staff
- Health Promotion
- Work with Health and Well- Being group
- Work with HR
- Working with external companies
- Chair swaps /ergonomic equipment loan
- Ergonomic training incorporated into mandatory update
- Screen savers

Potential future developments:


- Admin and clerical manager education
