Challenges for Occupational Medicine Diplomates

Employment opportunities - noted that the SOM/FOM/NSOH placement spreadsheet as attached could be used to find roles in the commercial sector and NHS. Noted there were often bureaucratic hurdles in joining a commercial company. Noted OH for GPs was limited

Support that would help Diplomates

Agreed a community of practice was needed e.g. support from the NHS and commercial providers.
