Unlimited indemnity


Unlike some commercial insurance policies, there is no limit on the indemnity that MDDUS will provide in respect of a claim.

Eligibility

In order to qualify for membership MDDUS traditionally required members to be on the relevant GMC specialist register or on the GP register. As a guide, doctors would be expected to hold at least the Diploma in Occupational Health and be able to demonstrate two years' experience of working in occupational medicine.
