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# How it all started.. the COVID story

- Solihull is the largest of JLR's UK sites: large routine and manual workforce /supply chain.
- Robust IPC and outbreak management processes throughout pandemic: joint Incident Management Team between JLR/ PHE/LA PH
- Site affected by large number of cases, peaking at >200 per week in second wave: both work to home / home to work and localised outbreaks
- January 2001 NHS Test and Trace pilot for workplace testing for surveillance, case finding and daily contact testing implemented
- First major workplace vaccination programme, run jointly with Birmingham and Solihull Integrated Care System
- On-site occupational health clinic operating 8-10 lanes, 35-45 staff mobilised on site, 2 mobile units to facilitate 'straight off shift' vaccination


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- Pre-booked appointments with additional walk-ins set up
- 8 day pilot: running on both operational & shut-down days
- 4502 staff and on-site contractors vaccinated
- JLR site deployed for mass public vaccination centre (OMICRON wave) & provided outreach transport support




