- ❖ **Dr James Hull**, Royal Brompton Hospital, London: *'Respiratory problems in Athletes – An Occupational Lung Disease?'*, discussing the high prevalence of respiratory problems in athletic individuals, and whether as such this could be considered an occupational hazard. He will cover exercise-induced asthma, cough and respiratory infection. He will also discuss doping and anti-doping implications in this context.
