- BHSF welcome applications from candidates wishing to switch speciality

BHSF's Occupational Medicine Training Programme is a four-year programme (pro-rata for part-time) starting at the equivalent to ST3. During this time, your work will be monitored for satisfactory progress subject to annual reviews of competency with the ultimate goal of being included on the GMC specialist register. A successful CESR application will lead to a substantive Consultant appointment at BHSF Occupational Health.
